# 1123 emergency food boxes 2850 people fed

Between 1 April 2023 and 31 March 2024, we gave out **1123** emergency food boxes to local people who didn't have enough money for essentials, feeding 1669 adults and 1181 children - that's a total of **2850** people. **2024/2025** has already started quite busy with **100** food boxes given out during April feeding **277** people, of which 116 were children.

The emergency food boxes are made up from food and other items generously donated by community and church groups, schools, local businesses and kind individuals - people like you! We do ask that the food that is donated is non-perishable and has a minimum of 4 months until the best before date as we are not allowed to give out anything that is out of date. We also ask that you check our Facebook page or website for the items that we most need; we've also listed our current shortages at the end of this newsletter.

Another way of staying up to date with our current needs is via the BanktheFood app.

The app is very simple to use. Download the app and follow the instructions to get started. Once you have followed Devizes and District Foodbank, the app will send you a helpful 'ping' with a reminder of your food banks' needs when you are shopping in your local supermarket. You can then choose exactly what you would like to donate and leave your donation in your food bank's collection box at the end of your shopping trip.

# **Volunteering for Devizes and District Foodbank**

# **Community Organiser**

Since February, the food bank's campaigning teams have had some major breakthroughs, and a new campaign has launched around the lack of furniture and fittings in social housing properties.

The team, UK Boaters for Energy Justice, made up of people with experience of financial hardship living on the waterways, worked with Wiltshire Council to raise awareness of boating households who've missed out on universal, historical support for increased energy costs. Because of the team's work, a £200,000 scheme for boaters was implemented which ran until 31st March and supported over 400 boaters with £600. This support has made a huge difference to boaters struggling with living costs.

A new campaign is bringing social housing tenants together to prevent households being moved into properties without flooring, curtains or the basic household essentials. It can cost tenants hundreds of pounds to make a property liveable, affecting their ability to afford food and bills, or else they're forced to go without the items we all need for health, safety, warmth and privacy.
