St James Foodbank Centre opened mid May this year. It took a while to get off the ground but is now proving to be quite successful.

People who have a voucher from a partner agency, are able to pick up their food parcels at these sessions. When they arrive at the centre, volunteers welcome them with a hot drink, offer to refer them to the Citizen's Advice (CA) caseworker attending the session, and provide further signposting support where possible.

Our visitors tell us how much they appreciate having someone willing to take the time to listen to them. They also welcome the chance to talk face to face with the CA caseworker.

During June, 15 of our visitors were seen by CA; the caseworkers dealt with 55 advice issues with the main areas being debt, and benefits and tax credits.

In the last few months, several campaigns addressing local causes of financial hardship have seen some amazing progress. With the help of families impacted by the issue, and the Devizes and District campaigning team, Devizes Change-makers, the first local school signed an Affordable Uniform Pledge. This commits them to ensuring uniform is affordable through reducing branded items and evaluating supplier value-for-money. We've also had a BBC article and Gazette & Herald article on this campaign! Engaging with Wiltshire Council on their Household Support Fund (£5.5 million for households to cope with the Cost of Living) has given local housing associations the opportunity to access some of the fund to support their tenants. Finally, Danny Kruger is attending a meeting on the national campaign to ensure social security is enough to afford the essentials, which it often isn't. A special food collection was held at Morrisons in Devizes on 22 July and a total of 492kg of food was donated by Morrisons shoppers. One boy spent all his pocket money on food items for us while some customers gave carrier bags full of food. Other customers told us that they had once been in a situation when they had struggled to afford to buy food and appreciated the work of the foodbank. Thankfully they are now in a better place.

We are so grateful for every single tin and packet that was donated. This will enable us to continue to provide emergency food to people in crisis in the Devizes, Marlborough and Pewsey areas.

The Trussell Trust are continuing to call on the UK government for an 'Essentials Guarantee' to make sure that the basic rate of Universal Credit is at least enough to afford the essentials we all need, such as food, household bills and travel costs.
